Geography

- Children will learn about what life would be like on an island.
- We will look at maps and a globe to discover where small and large islands are around Britain.
- Children will think about what it might be like to live in a small, secluded place and how their lives would be very different.
- Children begin to understand coordinates as they draw their own fantasy island map.

D&T

- Children design and make their own Moon Buggy to explore on the surface of the Moon.

Literacy

Narrative - Bob The Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram
We will be reading this series of stories which will lead to us planning and writing our own adventure for the main character.

Non - fiction - the children will research famous explorers to produce an autobiography.

Diary entries will be written from the perspective of different famous Explorers.

Art

- Children use various artists as a stimulus to produce their own 'Sea Scape' paintings.
- Children will think carefully about the colours they use.

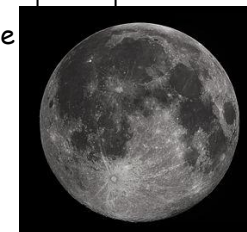
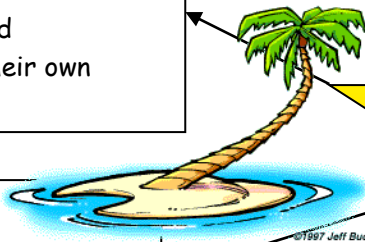
Explorers

History

- Children will look at the history of exploration and significant individuals.
- Children will put significant events in chronological order.
- Children will use ICT to find out about the past.

Science

- Children will learn about space, gravity, the Moon and how science has evolved to allow people to walk on the moon and visit space.
- Children will look at the diets of different explorers and look for links with the healthy eating topic from last term.
- Children will research the types of food an astronaut might take into space and how they might be different.
