Statement of behaviour principles:

The Combined Local Academy Committee of St Peter's C of E Academy, set out the following principles for behaviour within the academy:

- o Every pupil understands they have the right to feel safe, valued and respected, and learn free from the disruption of others
- o All pupils, staff and visitors are free from any form of discrimination
- o Staff and volunteers set an excellent example to pupils at all times and uphold the school values and policies of the academy.
- o Rewards, sanctions and reasonable force are used consistently by staff, in line with the behaviour policy
- o The behaviour policy is understood by pupils and staff
- o Exclusions will only be used as a last resort. School follow the DFE documents outlining the processes involved in permanent exclusions and fixed-term suspensions.
- o Pupils are helped to take responsibility for their actions
- o Families are involved in behaviour incidents to foster good relationships between the school and pupils' home life

The Combined Local Academy Committee also emphasises that violence or threatening behaviour will not be tolerated in any circumstances.
